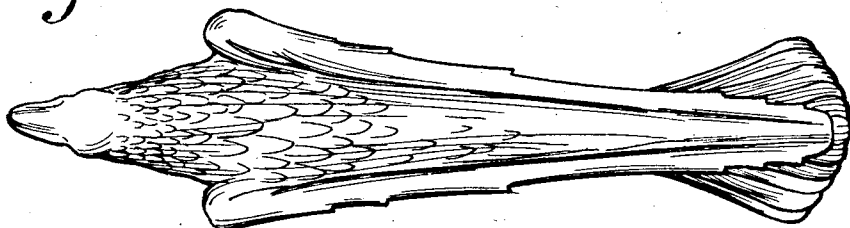

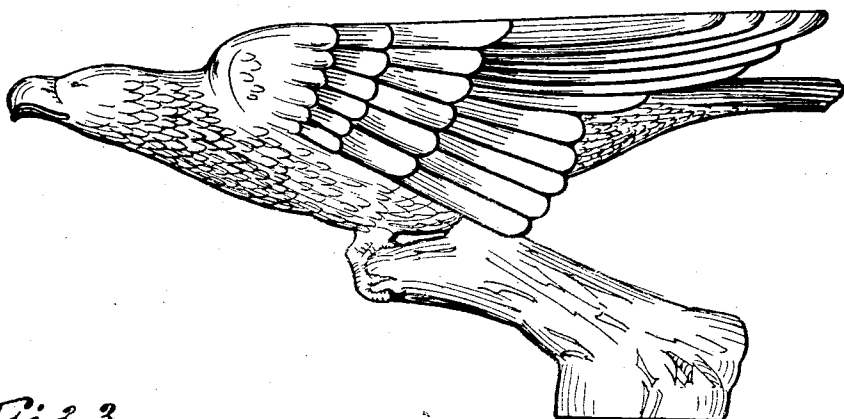
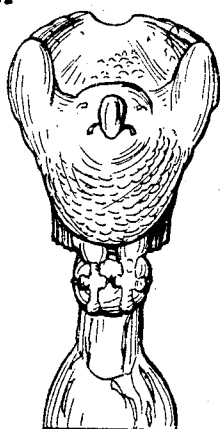

DESIGN FOR A RADIATOR-CAP ORNAMENT.

Application filed May 8, 1926. Serial No. 17,611. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, EMORY P. SEIDEL, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of River Forest, Cook County, Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Radiator-Cap Ornament, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part hereof, in which Fig. 1
